Caring for the Community

Neath Town Council have recently secured Big Lottery Funding to provide defibrillators throughout the town of Neath and the surrounding area. Working with CARIAD Defibrillators, Neath Town Council have installed three external units in the community.

Neath Town Mayor, Cllr. Mark Protheroe stated 'the Project is the result of Members of Neath Town Council realising there is a need for Defibrillators to be located in each of their community halls which cover a population of 19,000. These areas are also densely populated. All our community halls are located in key areas around the town and surrounding areas in particular where a large number of people gather and are scattered across a wide area and were considered priority areas for installation of the Units'.

Neath Town Council hall users and hirers such as the numerous clubs and societies who use our Community Halls as well as the local school and businesses will be comforted that this facility will be located within their community.

The three locations listed do not have Defibrillators available locally within the community which can be accessed on a 24/7 basis.

The installation of these Units with provide instant support in the community in those areas which are densely populated and located close to primary and comprehensive schools and Neath Town Centre.
