Climate Emergency Database - working document - commenced February 2022

Neath Town Council declared a climate emergency in February 2022. The declaration included a commitment to produce a Climate Action Plan within 12 months. The theory of change behind declaring a climate emergency is so that councils can provide leadership and help educate their communities about both the threat of and solutions to the climate crisis. Therefore, an Action Plans is to be developed to delivery all CE aims. The Climate Emergency Database is not as a stand-alone document but needs to embrace all aspects of Neath Town Council's Estates Plan going forward which will help promote health, wellbeing and equality. This Action Plan will look to build resilience in the face of the likely economic disruption from climate change in the future and identifies what Neath Town Council are planning and developing in its future Estates and Operational Portfolio to support this to encourage a self-sustaining Town Council.
